This charming classic of children's literature, written in 1911 by Frances Hodgson Burnett, is reimagined in brilliant musical style by composer Lucy Simon and Pulitzer playwright Marsha Norman ('Night Mother). Eleven-year-old Mary Lennox, orphaned by a cholera outbreak in India, returns to Yorkshire to live with her bitter and reclusive uncle. Archibald Craven, and his invalid son Colin. The estate's many wonders include a magic garden, which beckons the children with haunting melodies and messages from the "dreamers"-spirits from Mary's past who guide her through her new life, dramatizing The Secret Garden's compelling tale of forgiveness and renewal. The 1991 Broadway production ran for two years and won three Tony awards, including Best Book of a Musical. It was also nominated for Best Musical and Best Original Score.
